Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

EYFS	There were 22 pupils in the EYFS cohort. 59% of pupils passed met the expected standard at the end of EYFS. This is just below the Salford LA figure of 63% and the national figure of 70%
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Key Stage 1 Phonics

Key Stage 1 Phonics	There were 29 pupils in the Y1 cohort. 86% of the cohort passed the Y1 Phonic Screening test. This was above the Salford LA figure of 82% and national average of 82% (2017)
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Key Stage One SAT Assessments

Year 2 Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 73% of pupils met the expected standard or above at the end of Key Stage 1. This was just below the national figure of 76% and in line with the Salford average of 74%. ➤ 20% of pupils achieved the higher standard. This was 6% lower than the national average of 26% and 4% lower than the Salford average of 24%
Year 2 Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 70% of pupils met the expected standard or above in writing at the end of Key Stage 1. This was in line with the national figure of 70% and 3% above the Salford average of 67%. ➤ 17% of pupils met the greater depth standard which was in line with national average of 16% and Salford average of 15%.
Year 2 Mathematics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 77% of pupils met the expected standard or above in mathematics at the end of Key Stage 1. This was in line with both the national average of 76% and Salford average of 75%. ➤ 20% of pupils met the higher standard which in line with the national average of 22% and the Salford average of 21%.

Key Stage 2 Reading Progress and Attainment Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The progress measure for reading was 2.2 ➤ 77% of pupils met the expected standard or above in reading at the end of Key Stage 2. This was 2% above the national average of 75% and 3% higher than the Salford average of 74% ➤ 23% of pupils met the higher standard in reading. This was 5% lower than the national average of 28% and in line with the Salford average of 25%. ➤ The average scaled score for reading was 105 compared with 104 nationally.
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Key Stage 2 Writing Progress and Attainment Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The progress measure for writing was -0.2 ➤ 77% of pupils met the expected standard or higher in writing at the end of Key Stage 2. This was in line with the national average of 78% and in line with the Salford average of 77%. ➤ 15% of pupils met the greater depth standard in writing. This was 5% lower than the national average of 20% and in line with the Salford average of 19%.
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Key Stage 2 Mathematics Progress and Attainment Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The progress measure for mathematics was 3.4 ➤ 81% of pupils met the expected standard or higher in mathematics at the end of Key Stage 2. This was 5% higher than the national average of 76% and 4% higher than the Salford average 77%. ➤ 31% of pupils met the higher standard in mathematics. This was 8% higher than the national average of 23% and 10% higher than the Salford average of 21%. ➤ The average scaled score for mathematics was 105 compared with 106 nationally.
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Key Stage 2 Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation (SPaG) Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 85% of pupils met the expected standard or above in SPaG at the end of Key Stage 2. This was 7% higher than the national figure of 78% and Salford average of 78%. ➤ 27% of pupils met the higher standard in SPaG. This was just below the national average of 34% and 5% lower than the Salford average of 33%. ➤ The average scaled score for SPaG was 106 in line national figure of 106.
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
